FAQ Cambridge Program - Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Diploma

What is the AICE Diploma?

The Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Diploma is an international curriculum and examination system that emphasizes the value of broad and balanced study. Alongside in-depth understanding of a variety of subjects, students also need to master a broader range of skills critical for success in university study and employment.

The Cambridge AICE Diploma was first awarded in 1997 and has since become popular with a range of schools in different parts of the world. It offers students the opportunity to tailor their studies to their individual interests, abilities and future plans within an international curriculum framework. Students must take courses from three different subject groups (Mathematics and Sciences, Languages, Arts and Humanities and Interdisciplinary subjects). The learning process is student centered, active, inquiry based, and collaborative.

Cambridge Availability

The Cambridge Program is offered at middle and high school through Magnet Programs and also available at home boundary schools as an Innovative Program. The Magnet Programs may provide transportation and follow the School Board Policy, School Choice 5004.1.
