What is the International Baccalaureate Program?

The **International Baccalaureate**® (**IB**) founded in 1968, is a non-profit educational foundation offering four highly respected programs of international education that develop the intellectual, personal, emotional and social skills needed to live, learn and work in a rapidly globalizing world. The IB has a hard-earned reputation for high standards of teaching, pedagogical leadership and student achievement. High school students completing the diploma program can receive college credit if they pass IB exams. Students earning an IB diploma must take six interdisciplinary courses, write a research paper, and complete 150 hours of community service.

International Baccalaureate Availability

The IB Program is offered at all school levels through the Magnet Program and also available at home boundary schools as an Innovative Program. The Magnet Programs may provide transportation and follow the School Board Policy, School Choice 5004.1.
